City of Bakersfield Annexation 679 (Rosedale No. 13) & CSA 71 Detachment "R" REORGANIZATION

This proposal is to annex approximately 56.2 acres of land, generally located along the south side of Rosedale Highway generally between the Calloway Canal and Fruitvale Avenue. This annexation was initiated by the property owners for the purpose of gaining city services. The surrounding properties are Commercial, Industrial and Vista West High School.

This proposal does not have 100% landowner consent. The applicant has been informed that notice, hearing and protest hearing will not be waived. *(Resolution)*

City of Bakersfield Annexation 680 (Harris No. 05) & CSA 29 Dissolution REORGANIZATION & ISLAND ANNEXATION PROCESS

This proposal is to annex approximately 63.18 acres of land, generally *along the north and south sides of Harris Road and the east and west sides of Akers Road.* This annexation was initiated by the City Bakersfield for the purpose of providing city services. The surrounding properties are Residential, Public Park and Elementary School.

This proposal does not have 100% landowner consent. The applicant has requested an island annexation under California Government Code Section 56375.3 which requires notice, hearing and waives protest hearing. *(Resolution)*

City of Bakersfield Annexation 691 (Cottonwood No. 05) - County Service Area 11: Detachment "B" - Kern Sanitation Authority (KSA) Detachment "D"

REORGANIZATION

This proposal is to annex approximately 39.49 acres of land, generally located at the northeast corner of Feliz Drive and Cottonwood Road intersection. This annexation was initiated by the City of Bakersfield for the purpose of providing city services. The surrounding properties are vacant land, daycare facility and commercial.

This proposal does not have 100% landowner consent. The applicant has been informed that notice, hearing and protest hearing will not be waived. *(Resolution)*

6. <u>DETERMINATION PROCEEDING:</u>

Buena Vista Water Storage District: Annexation No. 01

This proposal is to annex approximately 636.15 acres of land, generally located along the south side of Stockdale Highway west of Interstate 5. This annexation was initiated by the District as property owners for taxation purposes. The surrounding properties are Agricultural and fallow.

This proposal has 100% landowner consent. A decision that this application meets the criteria for waiver of hearing, notice and protest hearing under California Government Code Section 5666 will be determined by the Commission. CEQA: Notice of Exemption. *(Resolution)*

City of Bakersfield Annexation 704 (Panama No. 25) Kern High School District

This proposal is to annex approximately 79.34 acres of land, generally located on the northeast corner of East Panama Lane and Cottonwood Road intersection. This annexation was initiated by the property owners for the purpose of gaining city services for the development of a high school. The surrounding properties are agricultural and residential.

This proposal has 100% landowner consent. A decision that this application meets the criteria for waiver of hearing, notice and protest hearing under California Government Code Section 56662 will be determined by the Commission. CEQA: Mitigated Negative Declaration. *(Resolution)*

City of Bakersfield Annexation 702 (Panama No. 24) Greenfield Union School District

This proposal is to annex approximately 49.23 acres of land, generally located on the southwest corner of East Panama Lane and Cottonwood Road intersection. This annexation was initiated by the property owners for the purpose of gaining city services for the development of a middle school. The surrounding properties are agricultural.
